GET READY TO WITNESS THE MAGIC OF GUGGENHEIM ABU DHABI

Designed by internationally acclaimed architect Frank Gehry, Guggenheim Abu Dhabi will be the largest museum in the Guggenheim network, spanning 11,600 square metres of interior gallery space and 23,000 square metres of outdoor exhibition areas. The iconic landmark encompasses a total built-up area of 80,000 square metres, making it one of the most significant art museums to be developed since 1960. Located on Saadiyat Island within the Saadiyat Cultural District, the museum is set to open its doors on 11 December 2026. It will present an exceptional collection spanning the 20th century to the present day, with particular emphasis on artistic movements from West Asia, North Africa, South Asia, and other regions that have played a defining role in shaping the global art landscape. The museum is further distinguished by its striking collection of sculptural galleries, inspired by the region's landscape, climate, and traditional architecture. Alongside its permanent collection and masterpieces displayed across 30 galleries, visitors can look forward to rotating international exhibitions, large-scale installations, artist commissions, educational programmes, and cultural events designed to foster dialogue and creative exchange. Its opening marks another significant milestone in the evolution of Saadiyat Cultural District, adding to a growing portfolio of cultural landmarks including Louvre Abu Dhabi, Zayed National Museum, Natural History Museum Abu Dhabi, and teamLab Phenomena. Together, these world-class institutions are transforming Saadiyat Island into one of the world's foremost cultural destinations, offering visitors an extraordinary journey through art, history, science, and innovation.
